CAMP CASA INTERNSHIP

Casa Mañana's Department of Education and Theatre for Youth is now accepting applications for 2019 summer camp internships. Casa Mañana Theatre is a professional regional theatre in Fort Worth, TX with a 60-year record of excellence in theatre education.

- Camp Casa Interns receive a weekly stipend of \$250.
- Camp Jr Interns receive a weekly stipend of \$125.
- Interns act as head counselors and lead a team of middle and high school counselors in training.
- Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis. The final deadline to apply is **May 1, 2019**.

CAMP DESCRIPTIONS AND DATES

CAMP CASA JR

Camp description: *For ages 4 to 8. Campers will learn creative expression using their voice, body and imagination, in a fun, no-pressure environment, with classes taught by seasoned theatre and education professionals! In addition, campers will work on theatre crafts to bring home with them at the end of camp. Each week-long session will feature songs, scenes, and crafts inspired by popular children's books. Campers perform their songs and scenes at the end of the week for their friends and families in the Casa Rehearsal Studios.*

- 4, week-long sessions, 8:30am-12:30pm, Monday-Friday
- June 3-7, 10-14, 17-21 and August 5-9, 2019
- Leading at all 4 sessions is not required.
- Interns act as summer camp counselors and assist performers backstage during performances.

CAMP CASA

Camp description: *A three-week summer camp experience for students ages 8-14 of all skill levels to come and participate in professional musical theatre training. Best of all, every registered camper will have the opportunity to rehearse and perform in a fully produced musical on Casa's main stage!*

- Monday-Friday, 8:30am-5pm, June 24-July 14 (no camp July 4 or 5), Performances July 12-14
- Interns act as summer camp counselors as well as backstage crew during performances.

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must be currently enrolled in an undergraduate program or have graduated in the last two years. Interns must have local housing and transportation. Experience working with youth is required and theatrical experience is preferred.
